Chapel Finances (as of August 30)





General Fund Budgeted: \$270,666.67 General Fund Receipts: \$304,973.90

This fund will have to cover whatever is approved for landscaping that exceeds money in B&G Reserve Fund.



Building & Grounds Reserve Balance: \$24,512.25

This is our most under-funded account. In addition to landscaping, our 7 heat pumps are getting long-in-the-tooth, the parking lots are going to need repaying, and several other facility needs have been identified.



Compassion Fund Balance: \$4,370.77

Compassion Fund YTD disbursements: \$12,151.76

Disbursements from the Compassion Fund assists local people with housing needs, food, utilities, and car repairs.



Scholarship Fund Balance: \$9,819.45

We give \$10,000 in scholarships each year. This fund is almost there for next June's awards, but it is never too early to start donating for 2027's awards.

Upcoming Chapel Highlights


- Communion Sunday, October 5th

Enjoy an inspiring afternoon of music with world-renowned hammered dulcimer artist **Joshua Messick**.


